There are notes on prescription and dangerous drugs legislation but the material is divided into three sections: -systemic materia medica; chemotherapeutics; s

therapeutics and biologicals (vitamins, hormones and vaccines). Within the (section antibiotics are adequately dealt with in 111 pages and sulphonamide Each chapter closes with a list of references taken mainly from recent public Relatively new drugs that have not found their way into this edition are the anthelmintics and the organic phosphorus insecticides (and anthelmintics) r ("Trolene"), trichlorphon (Dipterex) and Bayer 21/199 ("Asuntol"); but in eve respect the book is well up to date. The nomenclature of the British Veterin 1953 has been adopted and it is therefore necessary for the user of this bc the Codex for details of chemical or physical properties and adopted standa supplement to the Codex was published too late for this edition.] No practising veterinary surgeon can afford to be without this book.-R.M.
