Abstract : This book, written in an easy, popular style, considers whether circuses and zoos are cruel to animals, and discusses the arguments for and against zookeeping. The author, an ethologist who has studied wild and domestic animals, bases her discussions on observations of zoos and circuses in the UK over a period of 10 years. She concludes that while there are improvements that should be made, circuses and zoos in their nature cause suffering and distress in animals, and that the best interests of animals are not necessarily served by pressure groups trying to ban circuses and zoos.

This book will be of interest to all concerned about the ethics of exploiting zoos and circuses.
