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**Abstract**

German author Martin Walser paints a thrilling story of human existence in his novel *Ein fliehendes Pferd* (Runaway Horse). Nothing in the story is more complex than the personalities of the dichotomous characters Helm and Ingeborg. But the novel does offer an implicit opportunity for both characters to take their first step towards change in their lives. My analysis compares the similarities and differences between these two main characters' "escape attempts" and the meaning of the main theme (the runaway horse), and interprets the ambiguity of the novel's ending. Finally, I come to the conclusion that the middle point toward the implicit opportunity structured into the who's in the middle way between the two characters' polarizing lifestyles is the same for them both, as was Walser's masked intention with an epigraph.
