Marine boundaries between states of the United States and between the states and the United States have a long history. Disputes have arisen between states separated by a river and between states in extending their land boundaries seaward. The Territorial and Transcontinental Lands Act of 1953, disputes between states and the federal United States over title to valuable resources in the territorial sea, and disputes from the shoreline have been sharp and continuous. The legal basis for the delimitation of marine zones, including the law of the sea and international law, has been explored, indicating the reliance of courts on all three sources plus equitable principles.
