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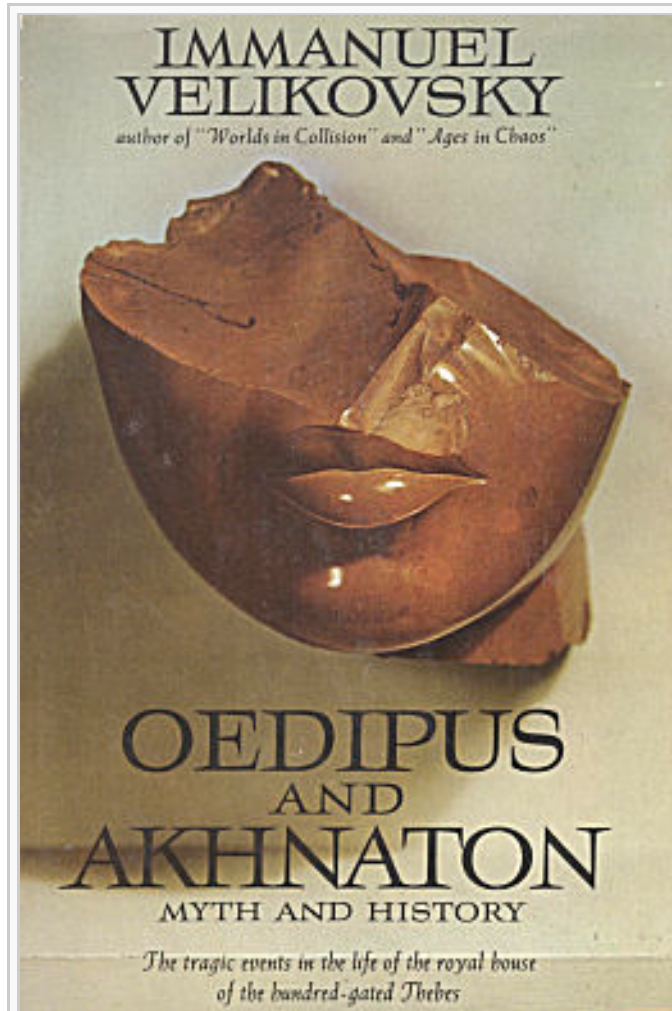
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Oedipus and Akhnaton

Oedipus and Akhnaton (1960) is Velikovsky's fourth book, and second in the series following *Ages in Chaos*. Velikovsky explains that he:

"... read Freud's last book, *Moses and Monotheism*, and was prompted to read more about Akhnaton, the real hero of that book. Soon I was struck by some close parallels between this Egyptian king and the legendary Oedipus. A few months later I found myself in the libraries of the New World, among many large volumes containing the records of excavations in Thebes and el-Amarna. This
