Abstract

The essential oils of *Salvia officinalis* and *Salvia triloba* cultivated in South Brazil were analyzed by GC–MS. The major constituents of the oil of *S. officinalis* were î±-thujone, 1,8-cineole, camphor, borneol and î²-pinene, whereas those of *S. triloba* were î±-thujone, 1,8-cineole, camphor, and î²-caryophyllene. The essential oils of both species exhibited remarkable bacteriostatic and bactericidal activities against *Bacillus cereus*, *Bacillus megatherium*, *Bacillus subtilis*, *Aeromonas hydrophila*, *Aeromonas sobria*, and *Klebsiella oxytoca*. Moreover, the essential oil of *S. triloba* efficiently inhibited the growth of *Staphylococcus aureus*. *S. aureus* and *A. hydrophila* growth were drastically reduced even in the presence of 0.05Â mg/ml of the essential oil of *S. triloba*.
