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Changing clothes: female dress and the widening Montgomery

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Abstract:

In her fiction, L.M. Montgomery (1874-1942) uses clothing as a tool to explore women's roles during changing. Montgomery's fiction shows dress being used in order to navigate new roles and negotiate visibility for women. This thesis links specific changes in women's lives during Montgomery's life to the increased presence of women in the paid labour force in relation to financial and emotional visibility and changing ideologies about sexuality and vanity and how these moral concepts are explored. It explores the influence of maternal feminism on the nation in the early part of the twentieth century and interest in both following World War I.
