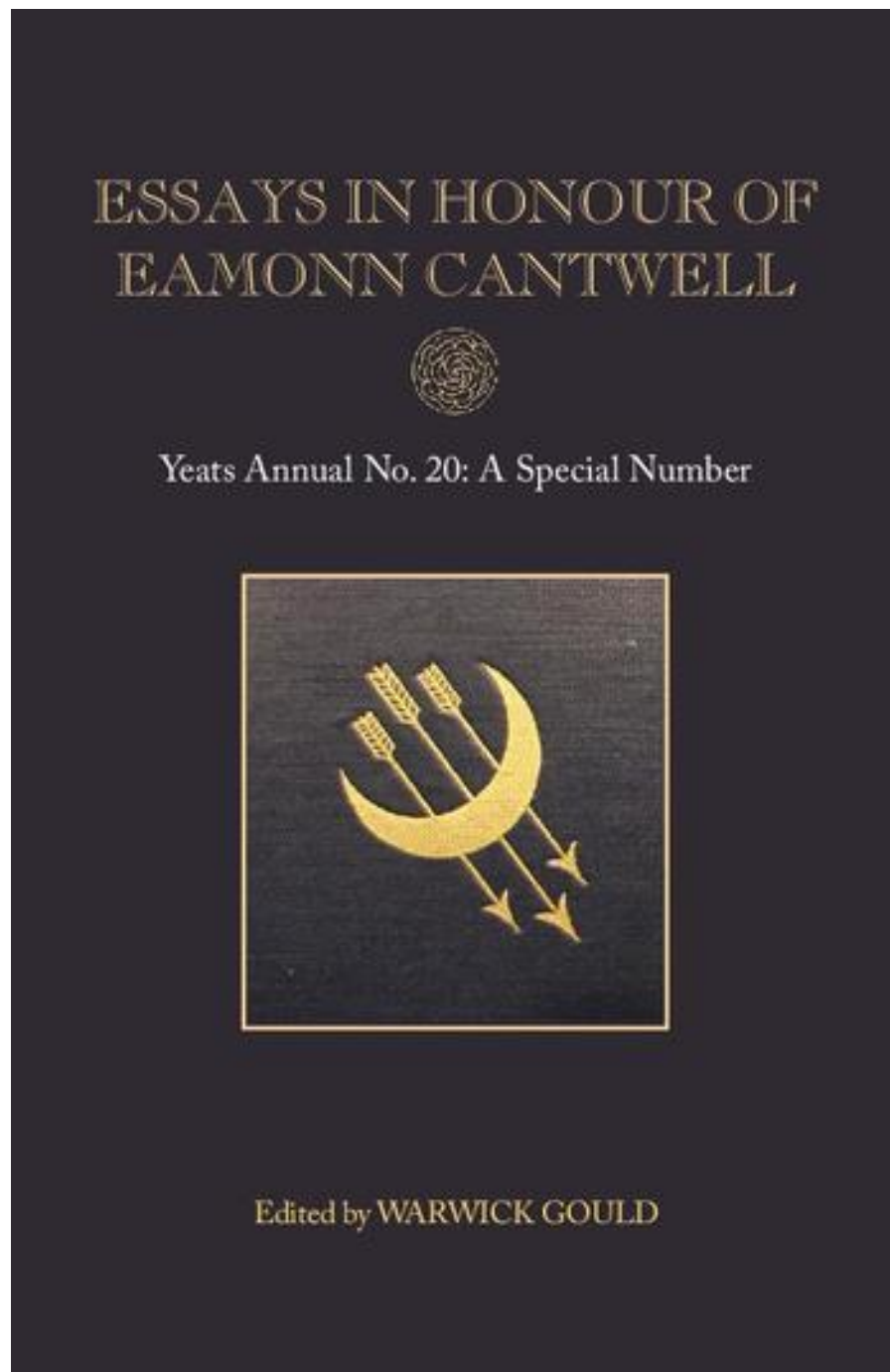


## Essays in Honour of Eamonn Cantwell : Yeats Annual No. 20

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**Abstract** "This number of Yeats Annual collects the essays resulting from the University College Cork/ESB International series. These revised essays cover such themes as Yeats and the Refrain, Yeats as a Love Poet, Yeats, Ireland sequences, and his long and crucial interaction with the emerging T. S. Eliot. The series was inaugurated by Cork, of Dr Eamonn Cantwell's collection of rare editions of books by Yeats (here catalogued by Crónán Ó Do) designs and resulting first editions.
