This study of trade books centered on three historical figures frequently included in elementary school curricula: Eleanor Roosevelt, Rosa Parks, and Helen Keller revealed various forms of historical misrepresentation and distortion. Reporting such lacunae is important for those involved in curriculum development. We believe children's books, even those with historical omissions, provide an unique opportunity for students to incorporate diverse perspectives as they actively assemble historical understanding from multiple narratives, even historically representative children's books, through source supplementation.
