Games and pastimes of various descriptions have always been an integral part of the cultures in the Torres Strait. There is an emphasis on the development, preparation, and maintenance of physical skills of the children and as well as environmental, communal, and personal happenings throughout life.

This bibliography has been produced to provide an awareness of play cultures undertaken by Torres Strait Islander peoples of these as part of an understanding of the sporting heritage of Australia.
