I address three common empirical questions about the connection between religion and morality: (1) Do religious beliefs influence moral behavior? (2) Do all religions universally concern themselves with moral behavior? (3) Is religion necessary for morality? Recent research on religious prosociality to reach several conclusions. First, awareness of supernatural monitoring and other factors encourage prosociality towards strangers, and in that regard, religions have come to influence moral behavior. Second, morality is culturally variable; this link is weak or absent in small-scale groups, and solidifies as group size and social complexity increase over time and across societies. Third, moral sentiments that encourage prosociality evolved independently of religion, as a result of social monitoring functions; therefore religion is not necessary for morality. Supernatural monitoring and related concepts like social solidarity and extend moral concern to strangers as a result of a cultural evolutionary process.
