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Abstract Since its publication in 1985, Peter Bellwood's Prehistory of the Indo-Malaysian Archipelago has been hailed as a landmark work in the field. Now that work has been fully revised and includes a complete up-to-date summary of the archaeology of the region as well as a comprehensive discussion of new and important issues (such as the "Eve-Garden of Eden" hypothesis in macrofamily linguistic classification. Moving north to south from northern Peninsular Malaysia to Timor a human prehistory from initial hominid settlement more than one million years ago to the eve of historical Hittite record provides the central focus, but chapters also incorporate essential information from the paleoenvironmental anthropology.
