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## Chapter Summary

Şadr al-Dīn Muḥammad ibn Ibrāhīm Shīrāzī (d.1640), better known as 'Şadr al-Muta'allihm' or 'Mullā Şadrā', is generally considered one of the most popular and influential thinkers of Shiite Islam. The first paragraph of the *Sharḥ ḥadīth al-kanz al-makhfī* repeats the problem raised by the addressee. The question essentially deals with the well-known philosophical problem of the reply begins with the author's statement that he received what is to follow through direct inspiration from God.
