Abstract : Among the subjects studied were herd composition, the dominance of the rut and sexual behaviour, and reproduction and family relationships. In 1957, under investigation the rutting season of the American bison was from mid-June to the end of Sep., but the fact that calves were sometimes born outside the main calving season indicates that rutting activity may occasionally occur at other times of the year. The main calving season was in April-May. As a rule, cows were sexually mature
