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#### Abstract

Charles Ives' vocal music is not commonly included as standard vocal repertoire for undergraduate and graduate students. The songs chosen for analysis in this paper all have in common a mixture of some degree of modernity alongside traditional elements that give the pieces an accessibility that is rarely found among modernist works. The five songs: A Christmas Carol, At the River, Serenity, Charlie Rutlage, and General William Booth Engine range in difficulty at multiple levels and will provide the building blocks for how a student should learn a piece of music: through style, historical analysis, and performance technique.
