Abstract

We consider the effects of development control on housing supply when the nature of the control is uncertain. Such controls contribute to the risk faced by housing suppliers. An increase in the variance of the controls will decrease current period supply of housing. Some implications are obtained for market supply behavior, which indicates that the presence of stochastic development controls may distort housing supply in unexpected ways.
