## Abstract

Study of the texts of 127 poems listed under “old age” in *Granger's Index of Poetry* indicates strongly negative attitudes about physical, emotional, social losses. The reading of poetry, a sensitizing experience, serves to reinforce negative stereotypes persistent in the media of mass culture.
