Abstract : The pattern of agricultural activity in Great Britain is described and discussed. The first part is concerned with those factors that circumscribe, in their varying degrees, the choice of enterprise, such as the land itself, the layout of farms, the availability of labour and equipment, and the location of the enterprise. The second part is a geographical analysis of the principal enterprises-(dairying, sheep, pigs, poultry, cropping and horticulture-and culminates in an attempt to classify these in types of farms and type of farming areas. The study is primarily concerned with the pattern of agricultural activity in Great Britain.
