

### Abstract

This publication offers a comprehensive and multispatial analysis of transnational life across the highly diverse diaspora is lived and imagined. In a detailed and stimulating discussion, the author unravels processes of identity construction in everyday life. Media consumption and communication technologies' appropriation become important in the formation of shared identities for populations spread across the globe. In exploring the future outlooks of diaspora this book adopts a spatial approach and looks into the locations of diaspora in the public, the urban and the transnational space. This multifaceted method reveals the complexity and tenacity of networks within the diaspora and beyond. The book has two dimensions.
